

How to Set Up a Dreamweaver Website at Home

Step 1. Copy the folder that has your website files onto your computer in a location where you can leave it (like on your desktop).

Step 2. Launch Dreamweaver. Click on the "Site" dropdown menu at the top and select "New Site."

Step 3. On the window that comes up, do the following:

- Give the site a name
- Click on the folder icon on the right and browse your computer to find the folder on your desktop and click the "choose" button in Dreamweaver

Step 4. To set up the site so it points to a remote server, click on the "Servers" tab on the left. Then, on the page that comes up, click on the "+" symbol at the bottom.

Step 5. Put in the FTP data. Give the site a name, put in an FTP server, a username and a password, then click the button to test the connection. If it brings back a successful message, click the save button and you should be good to go.

Step 6. To connect to the remote server, click on the "connect to server" button on the Files menu in the lower right corner of Dreamweaver. Click on the "expand" button on the top right corner of the Files menu to see a split screen that shows both the remote and local servers.

Step 7. Click on the files you want to upload in the local server window and then click the "up" arrow at the top of the screen (put) to upload them to the server.

Step 8. Check the internet to see if your files are there. They will be located at:

<http://www.dreamco.org/yourstudentletter/yourfoldername/yourfilename>

Note: when a screen pops up that says "Do you want to upload dependent files" you can say "no."
